

Pet Policy

We love well-behaved dogs, and they are welcome to visit us and stay at The Ferry Boat Inn. There is a grassy area within the grounds of The Ferry Boat Inn plus we are a short walk away from some beautiful river footpaths and dog-friendly walks.

For guests wanting to stay at The Ferry Boat Inn with their dogs, we have a few simple rules to ensure you, your dog and our other guests enjoy their stay.

- Dogs are only permitted in our spacious Barn and old pub areas, and in our dog-friendly B&B room. Please ensure you select the correct room type when completing your booking or speak to us directly to ensure you book the appropriate room.
- We permit a maximum of two dogs staying in your room per night. Whilst they can stay free of charge, we politely ask you to inform us if you are bringing a dog with you.
- Owners are required to bring their own dog beds, water bowls, dog bowels and dog towels.
- We politely ask you to keep your dog off the beds and furniture at all times.
- Dogs must not be left alone in the rooms.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times while at The Ferry Boat Inn
- Please be respectful to other guests & restaurant users. Not everyone will share the same love for dogs as you, so please keep them under control; and don't let them approach others without an invitation.
- There are grassy areas suitable for dogs. Please ensure that you clean up after your dog.
- There are some beautiful local walks directly from The Ferry Boat Inn, so just head to Reception for advice and a map.
- Owners will be liable for any damage caused by your pet.
- This policy does not apply to Guide Dogs or Assistance Dogs
